

# PLAQUES

Plaques are a staple for employee / donor / special event recognition. There are different types of plaques designed to fit all budgets and are found in sizes from 5" x 7" up to 24" x 36" with our prices starting at just \$5 each. Our website is designed to provide a general idea for pricing. Lasered Plaque pricing is determined by size of plaque, type of wood, the amount of lasering needed, and if engraved areas will be color filled. If your organization lasers 100 or more plaques per year, please contact us for custom plaque pricing. With our low overhead and state of art lasers, we are extremely competitive.

## TYPES OF PLAQUES

**Faux Wood** - These have names like "Oak Finish", "Simulated Walnut", and "Maple like. These are basically wood pulp and other forms of scrap covered by an ultra thin skin of synthetic material. These are the least expensive plaques on the market. If the scrap material underneath is light colored, you can laser engrave these and they look okay. Most companies use these as a base and add a large plate or other cover to complete their presentation.

**Wood** - Poplar Wooden plaques are made from Alder, Cherry, Maple, Pine, & Walnut. Alder is a favorite as many feel it offers the best look when laser engraved. With wood plaques, it's important to remember this is a natural product so no two will be the same.

**Pianowood** - has a high luster surface with a wooden underside. The best look is presented here when lasering, we mask the plaque in order to colorfill the engraving. This process involves more time to "clean" the plaque, however, this offers an elegant presentation.
